70% of students achieved
an A or B in the QCS

2015 saw the graduation of our fourth Year 12 class. Our graduates achieved outstanding academic results in 2015, with 67 per cent achieving an OP1-10 and 70 per cent receiving an A or B on the QCS Test. As well as achieving academic excellence, our 2015 graduates also demonstrated significant personal growth, dedication and enthusiasm inside and outside the classroom.

Our Year 12s were represented in a number of leadership forums, including the 2015 Premier's ANZAC Day Prize and the QUT Future Leaders Forum, and led programs across the College for many worthwhile causes. They also gave willingly of their time and experience to support and mentor younger students at the College, often demonstrating wisdom and compassion beyond their years.
