

Let's Keep it Moving / Let's Sing that Book!

Year 1 Music, Term 3 2020

During this unit, children discover how to sing stories. A variety of books are used such as "Going on a Bear Hunt", "The Ants go Marching" and "Underneath the Chestnut Tree". These books will develop confidence in singing and discovering melodic contour. They respond to and explore changes of speed (tempo) and repeat and create simple rhythmic phrases.

Students will continue to sing, play instruments, listen to, move and engage in musical play to explore and develop their musical skills and understandings. They make music by themselves and with others, learning a repertoire of rhymes, songs and singing games.

Skills

- Patterns of words rhythm
- Move and perform with an understanding of beat and tempo
- Practice of (ta) and (ti-ti) and Z (za)
- Pitch matching and singing in unison
- Melodic Contour

- Learn to sing 'in-tune' through exposure to songs of limited range and duration.
- Use clapping, marching, body percussion and Orff instruments

Assessment

- Check lists Pitch matching both in large and small groups
- Group singing and games
- Participation in group
- Observations
- Core Song Good Night Sleep Tight Learn to sing and play on xylophone

Students will use and understand vocabulary such as

- Smooth / Detached
- Rhythmic elements
