UNIFORM SHOP HOURS

All College uniforms (Prep—Year 12) must be purchased at either our Campus Uniform Shop located on the Junior Campus or EDSCO at Stafford.

Campus Shop Hours (during school terms)

Mondays 7:30am—9:30am
Thursdays 2:00pm—4:00pm

EDSCO Stafford

The School Locker is located at 12B Windorah Street, Stafford (near Bunnings at Stafford). It is open Monday—Saturday throughout the year with extended hours in January.

All students at Prince of Peace Lutheran College are expected to comply with all aspects of the College uniform (as set out for their year level) from the time of leaving home in the morning until they return at the end of the day. This includes while in transit and at shopping centres.

Junior Campus students will be advised at the beginning of the year which uniform to wear on which day. Senior Campus students will be advised at the start of each term when they receive their new timetable.

All uniform items, except shoes, stockings/tights and Junior School house shirts (see below) are to be bought from the College Uniform Shop.

Hats

Hats must be worn by students when travelling to and from the College, when off campus, or outside a building unless the students are directed otherwise by a teacher. A regulation College hat, must be worn during play and sports sessions. The principle of 'no hat, no play' applies all year round.

Formal hats must be worn with the Formal Uniform and during lunch break time on the days when the Formal Uniform is being worn.

Sports hats must be worn during sport activities and lunch breaks on the days when the Sports uniform is worn to school.

Hat Guidelines for Prep Students

Prep students are required to wear the College's Bucket Hat with their sports uniform each school day unless directed otherwise by a College staff member. The Bucket Hat is reversible, with the inside lining representing the College's Sporting Houses. Hence, parents and guardians will need to purchase the hat that corresponds to their child's Sports House.

Hat Guidelines for Years 1-6 Students

When wearing the Formal Uniform, all Years 1-6 students are required to wear the Navy Broadbrim Formal Hat.

When wearing the Sports Uniform or NISSA uniform (Years 4-6 only), all Years 1-6 students are permitted to wear either the College's Bucket Hat or their Navy Blue Broadbrim Formal Hat.

Hat Guidelines for Years 7-12 Students

All Year 7-12 students are to wear the Senior Formal Hat with their Senior Formal Uniform.

When wearing the Sports Uniform, students can wear either the Bucket Hat (with the correct House colour inside) or the Navy Broadbrim Formal Hat.

When wearing the NISSA Uniform, students can wear the Bucket Hat (with the correct colour inside), the Navy Broadbrim Formal Hat or the College's Sports Cap.

Shoes

Students are to wear College-approved shoes at all times. This includes formal black leather school shoes worn with formal uniform and predominantly white, black, or navy sports shoes worn with sports uniform.

Acceptable shoes for Y7–12 Design Technology and Food Technology

All students in Years 7–12 who study Design Technology or Food Technology will need shoes with a leather upper as mesh and fabric sports shoes do not provide adequate protection. If the student's sports shoe has a mesh upper, they will need to wear formal shoes to these lessons.

Coloured House Shirts

A coloured polo shirt in the student's house colour is required for inter-house sports competitions – Bradman (bottle green), Fraser (navy blue), Jackson (red) and Laver (yellow).

- Junior Campus students can wear a plain polo shirt (purchased elsewhere) or the official House Polo Shirt with logo from the Uniform Shop.
- Senior Campus students are required to purchase and wear the official house shirt with the logo on it from the Uniform Shop.

School bags

The College's navy school bag is compulsory from Prep—Year 12.

Hair

Students are to have conservative hair styles and be neatly groomed at all times. Hair is to be of a natural colour with no obvious colour contrasts. Hair should be styled so the College hat can be worn correctly. Students with shoulder-length or longer hair are to have their hair tied up while in uniform. Hair is to be secured with a band or head band of similar colour to the student's hair. White, navy or royal blue ribbons or scrunchies are acceptable. Students with short hair can have no shorter than a No. 1 blade and no longer than the collar. Hair longer than shoulder length needs to be tied up while in uniform. Undercuts, long fringes, rat's tails and so on are not permitted.

Boys are to be clean shaven.

Jewellery

A simple cross or other Christian religious symbol on a fine chain is the only item of jewellery to be worn with the College uniform. Rings are not permitted.

Students with pierced ears may wear one small pair of studs or small plain gold or silver sleepers.

Piercings, other than of one set of holes in the ears suitable for wearing stud earrings, are not permitted.

Students may wear a watch.

Make up and cosmetics

The wearing of make-up, cosmetics and nail polish is not permitted.

Tattoos

Tattoos are not permitted.

White ankle socks with navy and sky blue stripes

Tights

70 denier navy stockings or ribbed tights
NB: Track pants can not be worn under the dress.

Pullover

Unisex navy College pullover

Hat

Navy blue broad brim hat with embroidered logo

Hair accessories

White, navy or royal blue ribbons or scrunchies can be worn with the formal uniform, the sports uniform or the NISSA uniform. House coloured accessories are permitted when wearing the house shirt.

NB: Accessories can be purchased through the uniform shop or at local shopping centres.

Unisex, navy blue, white and sky blue
NB: To be worn with sports uniform only.

Track Pants

Unisex, navy blue with white and sky blue

Sports hat

Option 1—PoP Sports Cap

Option 2—Navy College bucket hat with white embroidering and house colour or College Cap

Sports House Shirts

The house shirt with the logo is compulsory for Years 7-12 students. These can also be purchased from the Uniform Shop.



NISSA Sports T-Shirts—Years 7-10 ONLY

Students from Years 7-10 are required to purchase a NISSA Sports T-Shirt for weekly interschool sports (NISSA competition). This shirt is worn with our Sports Uniform shorts or skorts.

Students playing netball or basketball will be loaned a netball dress or basketball set (singlet and pants) for the season. Netballers will need to purchase their own PoP bike pants.

General Information

Exchanges and refunds

Exchanges may be made on new uniform items provided they are:

- returned within four weeks of purchase,
- returned in the original packaging with tags attached, and
- accompanied by a register docket as proof of purchase.

Please choose carefully as we do not give refunds, but gladly exchange items returned in 'as new' condition. Items for return should be sent in a plastic bag with your child's name, class and size required. Items considered faulty will be returned to the manufacturer for a decision before a credit can be issued.

End-of-year purchases

When purchasing at the end of the year for uniforms being worn in the new year, please consider putting the uniforms aside unwashed and unlabeled (with tags attached) until you are comfortable that the sizings are correct. If on your final check you find the items are no longer a suitable fit, they can be exchanged upon presentation of the item in an 'as new' condition and your receipt (see above).
