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Why learn music?

In addition to being a fun, social activity for your child, learning a musical instrument has been shown to develop fundamental life skills and high level cognitive processing within the learner.

Listed below are some key competencies your child could become proficient in by learning a musical instrument.

- develop creative skills through composing, improvising and performing

Instrumental Tuition

Our music department offers tuition across both the Junior and Senior campus on the following instruments:
