

# CHERMSIDE AND STAFFORD BUS RUN 2021



## Information Sheet

Thank you for your enquiry regarding the College bus service to The Mitchelton, Stafford and Chermshire area. Details of pick up/drop off places and times are detailed on the following page. Please note the bus will stop as scheduled only and that no other stops will be permitted. Students need to be at their collection point at the correct time, the bus will not be able to wait for them.

The fare for full time use is \$380.00 per student per term with an adjustment in Term 4 to reflect the 39 weeks, and will be charged on each Term fee statement at the beginning of the Term. Part time users for 5 trips or more a week will be charged \$4.20 per trip per student and those using the bus 4 trips or less will be charged at the casual rate of \$5.50 a trip.

From 2021 all full time and part time fees will continue to be charged on each Term fee statement at the beginning of the Term. Casual fees will be able to be paid via the Bus Minder Parent App. Please see the link below on how to set up and top up your account.

Once a student is allocated a seat on a full time or permanent part time arrangement, this seat is then guaranteed for your student. As a discount has been applied, no reimbursement will be given for students who are sick or do not use their seat. Should you need to make changes to your bookings, please notify us in writing via email, preferably one week before the commencement of a new Term.

Prince of Peace has implemented a GPS-based app for its bus network that allows parents to track their child's school bus, via their smart phone. The secure, user-friendly Bus Minder Parent app can be downloaded from the Apple App Store (for Apple devices) or Google Play Store (for Android devices).

Bookings are taken in the order of receipt of relevant paperwork. Please note that there are a limited number of places available. If you wish to use the bus service on a casual arrangement, please submit paperwork prior to using the service, any bookings to travel on a casual basis must be made by calling or emailing the bus department.

This bus run is allocated a mobile phone number for emergency purposes 0409 108 757. Absentees can be made through the Bus Minder APP, please ensure this is by 6:15am for an AM trip and 2:15pm for a PM trip. All other amendments to bus bookings are to be advised to the email address detailed below.

Bus routes are set based on the location of applications received, please note that we cannot always offer a door to door service, however will we endeavor to pick up and drop off at a convenient and safe location. Please note bus routes are subject to change prior to Term 1.

## PRINCE OF PEACE LUTHERAN COLLEGE BUS STUDENT

### CODE OF CONDUCT

#### STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

- While at bus stop and/or station wait quietly and behave in an orderly manner when disembarking / boarding.
- Driver's instructions must be followed at all times.
- Seatbelts must be worn at all times when on the bus.
- Do not stand at any time.
- Move to the back of the bus if you are not getting off at the first stop.
- Act safely and have respect for other passengers and property.
- Keep school bags off seats by stowing them in the parcel rack or under the seat.
- Travelling on the College Bus is deemed a privilege, not a right.
- Students are to remain seated on the bus until they are at their destination and the bus has come to a complete standstill.

#### UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR

- Dangerous behaviour such as pushing and shoving at the bus stop while waiting and especially as the bus approaches.
- Eating or drinking on the bus.
- Having any part of your body outside the bus.
- Resting feet on seats or any action that will mark or damage any part of the bus.
- Fighting, yelling, kicking, spitting, hitting, swearing or any other offensive action that causes discomfort for other passengers or distracts the driver's attention.
- Throwing or spreading any item around inside the bus or out of the window.
- Any inappropriate behaviour that places the reputation of the College in jeopardy.

#### WHEN A STUDENT MISBEHAVES - Step 1

- A. The driver will speak to the student about improving their behaviour.
- B. The driver may require the student to move to a seat where behaviour can be monitored.
- C. When incidents of misbehaviour occur the driver will record details such as dates, student's name, actions, times, year and home class teacher's name.

#### SHOULD BEHAVIOUR NOT IMPROVE - Step 2

- A. The driver will advise the student that their continuing misbehaviour is being reported to the Head of Campus.
- B. The driver will collect records and details of misbehaviour incidents and complete a Discipline Slip and hand to the relevant Head of Campus as soon as practicable.

#### SHOULD MISBEHAVIOUR CONTINUE - Step 3

- A. The driver may require the student to attend a meeting with the Head of Campus. It may be necessary for the parents or guardians to also attend such a meeting.
- B. The College may refuse to carry the student on the College bus for a period which will reflect the seriousness of the misbehaviour.

#### MOBILE PHONE AND PERSONAL DEVICE POLICY

- Student's may use a phone for music only, and must be wearing headphones. No other device is allowed. Phones must not be used for recording and distributing material.

## Bus Minder Parent APP - Information

We have been using Bus Minder now at Prince of Peace for just over 4 months. As a parent, Bus Minder enables you to view the real-time location of your student's bus, their boarding location, and whether your student is on board. You will also be able to mark your student absent for either the AM, PM or both trips for the day.

There is a trial feature on the parent app, which gives parents the option to "create booking" that is under "manage schedule". Accessing this gives you the option to mark an absentee for the future or to book future travel, however this will create a request that **will need to be approved** by the College Bus Administrator before it is confirmed as booked. (As this is a trial, it is only visible on an iPhone)

On the screen you will notice a reference to payments, for 2021 the College will continue to bill all full time and part time bookings, however for 2021 we will be implementing the payment system for casual bus users.

A few things to note:

- An absentee for the morning will need to be made by 6:15am, otherwise the driver will not see it. Once a driver logs in for the morning, they will not receive any further absences.
- Please have your student at the stop 5min before scheduled time. The driver will leave the stop after the designated time, he will not be able to call if your student is not there
- Bus Minder may currently only have one emergency email registered per family. If you are unable to login, it may be because your email is not registered. In this instance, please drop me a quick email and I will register your email. Please state your student's name for reference.
- Students in Year 7-12, can use their school email address to access the app on their phones. If you would like your Junior Campus student to use this feature, please let me know as I will need to liaise with the school IT Department.
- Parents will still need to contact the school for extra trips, or changes to their current arrangements, please do this via email.

### How do I install and use the app?

The secure, user-friendly Bus Minder Parent app can be downloaded from the Apple App Store (for Apple devices) or Google Play Store (for Android devices). Here are a few tips for setting up and using the app:

- To set up Bus Minder on your phone, download the app and click on *Login*, then '*Forgot your password?*'. This will enable you to set a password.
- Once you have logged in, you will be asked whether the app should be allowed to send you notifications. We strongly encourage you to **allow** notifications to enable you to see the location of the bus in real-time, which will help you determine the appropriate time to drop your child(ren) at the pick-up location, or to meet the bus in the afternoon.
- Bus Minder can also alert you when your child boards the bus in the morning and boards and alights the bus in the afternoon.
- The Parent app also contains an alert feature that can be used to send push notifications to your smartphone if there is a problem that may affect the bus run that day. ie a bus delay
