

Music Around the World

Year 6 - Music - The Arts Term 1, 2022

In this Unit, students will 'travel the world' and explore folk songs from a variety of countries. They will be exposed to many types of music they may never heard before. Students will also recognise that different cultures have different types of music, and they should be celebrated for their uniqueness.

Skills

Pitch and Melody

- Practice the extended do pentatonic scale
- Play a variety of percussion instruments both tuned and un-tuned
- Plays chords on an instrument (ukulele / guitar)
- Practice the do pentatonic scale drm sl
- Play a variety of percussion instruments both tuned and un-tuned
- Recorder Revision of D',C', B, A, G, E,
- Low D and F# are focus for Term 1
- Investigate major and minor tonalities.

Assessment

- Observation and Check lists Pitch matching both in large and small groups
- Singing, playing and reading known and unknown music
- No written test in Term 1

In preparation for the Performance Task in Term 2, students will learn several folk songs and will be provided with different tasks for assessment.

Students will use and understand vocabulary such as

- Folk Songs and Cultural reference
- Recorder real note names on the Treble Staff
- Tone Colour String instruments
