Languages, Spanish Year 3 -Term 1, 2022

Hola familias and welcome back!

I am so excited for another year of Spanish at Prince of Peace. In Year 3, we will continue to build on students' knowledge and practice the language through different activities. By now, students are feeling more confident in their ability to have a go at speaking Spanish words and phrases without feeling as self-conscious and recalling some of the basic vocabulary learned in previous years.

In Term 1, students will revise greetings and farewells from last year, but they will also learn how to ask and give further basic personal information. Students continue to expand their number practice and knowledge of the calendar. Old vocabulary such as colours will also continue to be revised through songs or other activities.

The lesson will comprise of three parts:

- Calendar practice (days, numbers, months, year)
- Development of targeted vocabulary through various activities.
- Goodbye words

Skills

- Interact with teacher and peers to greet and farewell others and drill new vocabulary
- Participate in guided group activities
- Recognise and reproduce the sounds and rhythms of simple spoken Spanish
- Recognise and respond to classroom interactions

Assessment

- Observations
- Numbers 1-31
- Greetings, farewells and other personal information assessment.

Semester Task: Please encourage your child to practice the new words at home in fun ways such as using post it notes around the house, playing snap or memory with the new vocabulary, word hunt, chalk writing etc.

Students will use and understand vocabulary such as

- Greetings, farewells and personal information
- Calendar words and expressions
- Numbers 1-31
- Colours
