* Note: As a Lutheran College, Christian Studies is a core subject that students are to study from Prep to Year 12. Students have the following choices for their religious education program.

Option 1: Religion and Ethics (Applied) begins in Year 10 as an accelerated subject so students will be able to complete the majority of units by the end of Year 11. However, one unit of Religion and Ethics is studied until the end of Year 12. When students are in Year 12, Religion and Ethics will occur for a smaller lesson allocation which means they will have a line for study whilst still doing 5 general subjects.

Option 2: If students wish to study 6 general or applied subjects, then they will be involved in a Christian Studies program in Year 11 and 12 with smaller lesson allocation. Therefore, they will have 6 subjects in Year 12, which will mean they will not have a study line.
