

I have had the pleasure of working alongside a group of dedicated, supportive, and beautiful people who have inspired me every step of the way. Music Director Linda Brady

I come from a family of singers and I was at university before I discovered that, not everyone spends a country car trip singing in 4 part harmony and changing key on a cue from the driver. Brought up on traditional church music, I was a Old Opera young artist and then chorister for 15 years, I have sung in a jazz trio, and I have represented Australia internationally with a 6 part vocal sextet, singing for the late Queen Elizabeth II and the late Pope John Paul II. I love the sound of voices raised together in song and its power to impact the human soul and build community. Directing the music for Shrek the Musical was an absolute joy. The songs are fun and catchy, conceived as a musical pastiche rich in popular music styles ranging from 60s pop to acoustic folk rock to jazz to RnB to dance. There are abundant Broadway references and even glimpses of Tchaikovsky. It is a musical smorgasbord, full of tasty favourites and our singers responded organically to the tangible familiarity of the music. Perhaps one day we will have enough students to run our own band but on this occasion we loved being able to enjoy the professionally produced backing tracks and focus our energy on the singing. Because of our great choral traditions and with the long standing support and input of Sherree Cudney and Jenny Howlett, we were able to draw on a wealth of vocal experience, expertise and tradition in our young singers. It was wonderful also, sharing the creative process with my dear friend and Director, Lisa Rachow, whose vision is always so strong and clear and who is always ready for a laugh. My job as Music Director was really just being ears outside of the sound, constantly reminding us all how to be our best selves and keep driving that bar even higher. Probably our biggest challenges musically will have all come in this last week as we adjusted to a new space, microphones, our final backing tracks (which don't say "rehearsal track" every 30 seconds!) and an audience. Thank you all for your patience and for believing in us enough to come today. It is you who will make this show come to life.
