The iPad can be found on the shelf as you walk in through the gate. If you need help with setting up your Xplor account, please see one of our staff and we are more than happy to help.

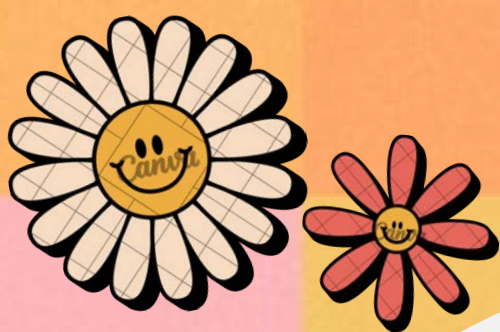
