In seeking to recognise the service and growth of our children and young people the awards consist of three levels of achievement in Academic, Cultural and Sporting. These are Gold, Silver, and Bronze.

Prince of Peace Awards fall under five categories as follows:

Service Awards
Spirit of Prince of Peace Award: Year 12 student
Spirit of Prince of Peace Award: Year 6 student
Servant Heart Medallion: one student from each year level (the top Servant Heart Award recipient)
Servant Heart Award: all students who meet the criteria in each year level
Leadership Awards
ADF Long Tan Leadership Awards: one student from each year level - Years 10, 11 and 12
RSL Spirit of ANZAC Award: one student from each year level - Years 7, 8 and 9
Lighthouse Leadership Award: one student from each year level - Years 4, 5 and 6
Cultural Awards

Cultural Gold, Silver and Bronze: all students who meet the criteria in each year level
Sporting Awards

Academic Awards
College Dux and Proxime Accessit: Year 12 student
