

Blue Card Information

It is the College's preference that all people working with children have a Blue Card. This is especially important for those people who want to attend excursions or camps.

Please read the details regarding obtaining or renewing your card and follow the instructions. As part of this process, you will need to prove your identity and obtain a customer reference number (CRN).

Please note that there is no fee to pay for a blue card if you are only volunteering.

Once you have obtained your CRN number, please send this information to Karen Osborne at kosborne@princeofpeace.qld.edu.au along with your date of birth. With this information, we can link you to Prince of Peace and your application will be able to be finalised with the department.

Once you receive a copy of your new blue card, could you please provide a copy to Karen Osborne. Karen Osborne is also the person to send a copy of your existing blue card – front and back, should you already have one.
