

Toddle – View Notifications on the App

As a family member, you can access your notifications on the mobile app by clicking on the **bell icon** on your homepage.

The notifications panel provides a comprehensive view of all your notifications. They are segregated into two tabs:

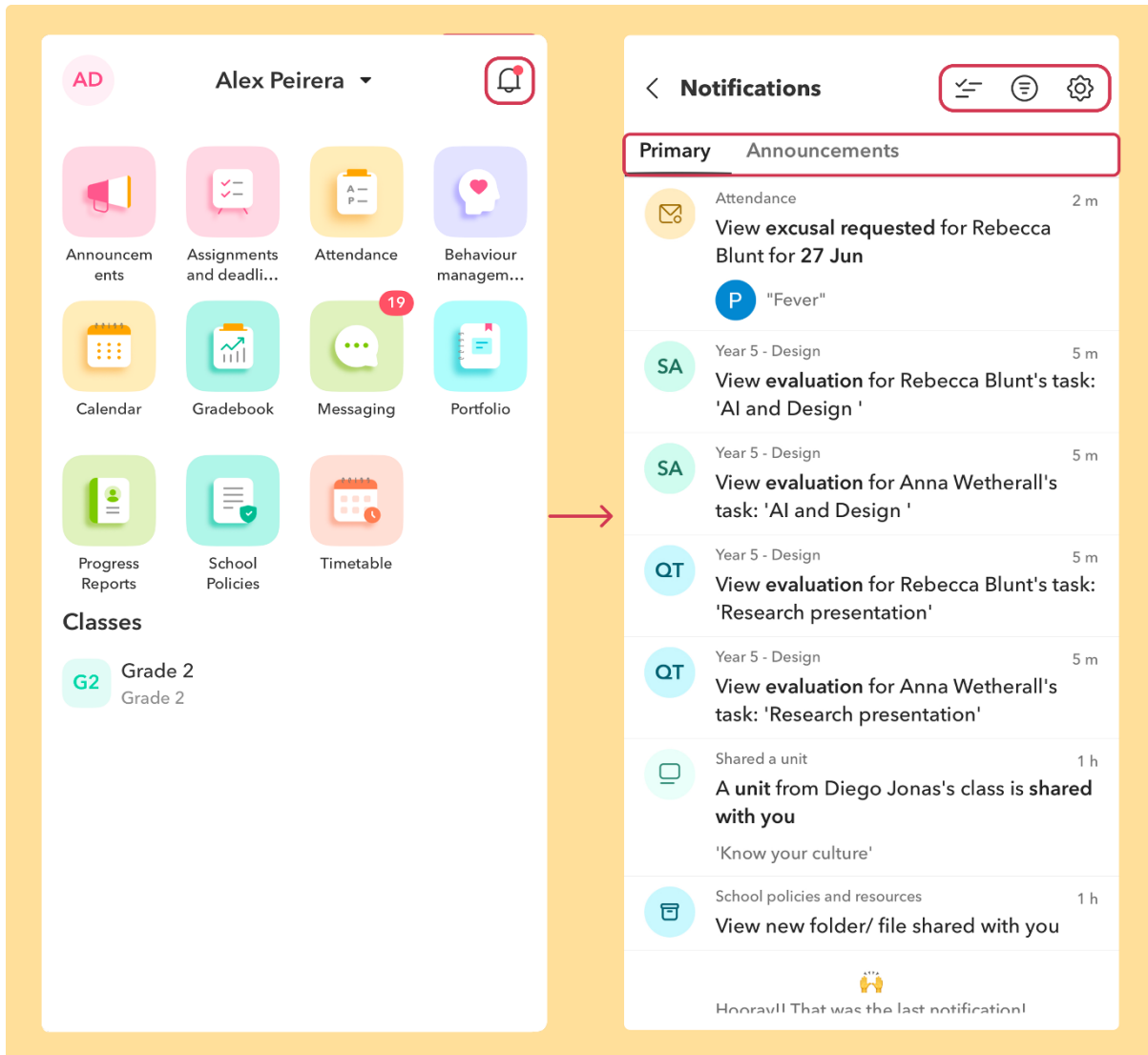
- **Primary-** For notifications related to task evaluation, unit sharing, and more.
- **Announcements-** For notifications specific to announcements

Each notification includes an icon showing its source (e.g., Unit plan) and a brief description of the activity, along with the time it was received. You can click on any notification to be taken to the relevant area of the platform where it was triggered.

Additionally, use the following features to help you navigate notifications efficiently:

- **Mark all as read icon:** Mark all notifications as read.
- **Show only unread icon:** Filter out the notifications that are unread, helping you manage large volumes efficiently.
- **Gear icon:** Customise notification preferences.

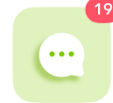

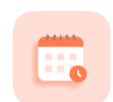
